YNCU will plant one tree for every GIC purchased and for every switch from paper to e-statements.

"The Plant a Tree program is one way we're contributing to the fight against climate change while offering our members competitive rates on their investments."

YNCU aims to plant 2,000 trees as part of this initiative, and progress can be tracked on the <u>YNCU</u> <u>website</u>. As part of this effort, 400 trees will be distributed across London, Woodstock, Stratford, Mitchell and Uptown Waterloo branches through <u>ReForest London</u>. Additionally, 100 trees will be planted in a sponsored local microforest with Sustainable Waterloo Region and 1,500 trees will be planted across Canada in areas in need of reforestation through Tree Canada, a national non-profit organization.
