"Our goal is to remove barriers and introduce as many people as possible to this classic Canadian winter activity," adds Colangelo. "We hope to see many new skaters on the ice this March Break!"

YNCU encourages individuals, families, and community groups to take advantage of this unique opportunity to learn a new skill in a fun and supportive environment.
